Comprehensive pain relief

Children's pain has historically been undertreated in hospitals. We're committed to changing that. Along with child-safe medications, nerve blocks and implantable pumps, we use a variety of non-pharmacological treatments such as pain relief devices, acupuncture and acupressure, massage therapy, aromatherapy and hypnotherapy. With integrative medicine, patients can achieve better pain control with far fewer side effects.

Caring for the mind and the body

Experts now understand that depression, anxiety and trauma amplify pain. Our psychologists use cognitive behavioral therapy, biofeedback (training to control the body's stress responses) and other therapies to interrupt that feedback loop and help kids feel better.

Supporting families as well as patients

Serious illness poses challenges for families in many ways and we're here to help them in navigating these challenges. Our expert staff helps families identify their care goals and make difficult medical decisions. Grief-support specialists provide compassionate care for parents and siblings going through anticipatory grief and bereavement.

We're growing to better serve more patients. As we welcome new clinicians from different disciplines to our team, we're breaking ground on a beautiful new center in San Francisco. Spacious, light-filled and decorated with artwork inspired by nature, it's designed to soothe and delight young patients.
